






### GOLF CLUB BADEN-BADEN E.V.

### GOLFCLUB JOHANNESTHAL E.V.

For more than 25 years, our guests have appreciated the challenging and top-maintained golf course. 18 holes are picturesquely embedded in the lower slopes of the Kraichgau hills and give the golf course a very special character. The course corresponds to the claim of being a sporty club, with relatively wide holes and flat, easily manageable bunkering that meanders over the chains of hills, but can bite back when the game becomes too imprecise. Because the strategically cleverly interspersed rough zones are nice for the eye, but bad for the score. The same applies to the water hazards that have to be overcome either on the tee or on the approach to the green.

With this feel-good package, a visit to the excellent restaurant in the listed clubhouse is a must.

### **GOLF DE LA WANTZENAU**

Ten kilometres from Strasbourg lies the Golf de La Wantzenau. The course was designed by the well-known English architect Jeremy Pern, and assisted by one of the best professionals in French golf, Jean Garaïalde. Water is an integral part of the versatile course, but long fairways and wooded holes also characterise the course. It's a course designed for all levels of ability: A training area open to the public includes a 12-hole compact course, a covered driving range, a grass range and a putting green. In this 72-hectare countryside setting, the clubhouse's architecture is reminiscent of the great Alsatian heritage. After the round, people meet to relax on the terrace, enjoy the delicious cuisine of the restaurant or refreshments at the bar.









